Who: Children ages 8-15

Where: Performing Arts Center at WNCC (lobby and theatre)

When: April 24th

Time: Due to Covid, we are only having 10 campers audition at once. You must sign up for an audition time.

How to sign up: We're using SignUp.com to organize our event.

Here's how it works in 3 easy steps:

1. **Click this link** to go to our invitation page on SignUp.com: <https://signup.com/login/entry/967015164350902068>
2. **Enter your email address:** (You will NOT need to register an account on SignUp.com)
3. **Sign up!** Choose your spots - SignUp.com will send you an automated confirmation and reminders. Easy!

Note: SignUp.com does not share your email address with anyone.

Please arrive at the beginning of your time slot.

Audition note: Your camper does not need to physically audition, whether it's due to anxiety, being out of town, or Covid issues. If your camper just wants to attend camp and not audition for a part, fill out the forms and turn them in with your payment. They will be placed in one of the choruses. Or, they can do a video audition if absolutely necessary. Email Kim for more info.

Cost: \$125 (\$75 for remaining children in the same family); fee may be made in two payments; limited scholarships available (email Kim for application).

If you are unable to download and print these forms, you can pick up a registration packet at the Theatre West Box Office, which is open Mon.-Fri., 1pm-6pm, and Sat., 8am-Noon. If you will not be at Registration/Auditions that day, please return your packet to the Box Office with your payment BEFORE April 24. You must wear a mask as per WNCC's Covid protocol.

Audition Requirements: No advance preparation necessary! Those auditioning will sing part of a song from the show (in groups). They will also be asked to repeat a line.

Special note: All who register and audition are in the show. Furthermore, TOFY camp is for everyone from age 8-15 regardless of disabilities. Modifications will be made to include everyone.

Call-Backs: Call Backs for main roles will be April 25 at 2pm in Performing Arts Center Theatre. You will receive a paper with further instructions at Auditions. PLEASE make sure you have this information before leaving!

Cast List: Will be posted on Facebook and emailed as soon as possible after call-backs (usually within 48 hours).

Other Camp Information

All-Camp Read-Through: We are NOT doing a read-through this year. You will receive your camper's script at auditions with your paid registration. PLEASE PUT THEIR NAME ON IT IMMEDIATELY. You can write in their character or chorus assignment later. All campers are required to memorize all lines and songs BEFORE CAMP. Music links will be provided on Facebook or via email for practice.

What We Do: TOFY campers will take part in all aspects of this musical children's theatre production. In addition to the lead roles, there will be several choruses ... Winter/Spring ensemble, Kingdom people (servants, villagers, ball attendees), and Woodland Folk. Additionally, campers will learn about non-

acting theatre tasks. For those campers who register as non-performers, we have jobs in several areas including sets, props, costumes, spotlight operators, and other technical and backstage help. If your camper is a non-performer, write that on your audition form, and Kim will email you.

Staff: Campers will learn under the supervision of Theatre West Repertory Company members and dedicated high school/college and adult volunteers.
